ABOUT THE COMPETITION

The Datathon & Machine Learning Competition is a unique opportunity for students from around the world. The first part of this competition will do a deep dive on how to identify anti-Jewish hate. The second part of this program will challenge students to apply that knowledge to the development of machine learning algorithms that analyze online content for antisemitic bias. Teams will be scored on how accurately they identify content as antisemitic, both manually and with the machine learning algorithms that they train over the course of this competition.

Eligibility:

- No prior knowledge is required, but experience with programming will be useful.
- High school and undergraduate students from all countries are welcome to apply for the competition. All others can apply for the non-competitive track.
- Participants will need access to a computer and an internet connection. All workshops will be conducted over Zoom.
