



2025 Datathon & Machine Learning Competition to Combat Antisemitism

The **Datathon & Machine Learning Competition** is a unique opportunity for students from around the world to collaborate with researchers from Indiana University to analyze datasets and identify antisemitic bias on major social media platforms. Teams will be scored on how accurately they identify content as antisemitic, both manually and with the machine learning algorithms they train over the course of the competition.

Selected participants will receive a certificate recognizing their achievement and skills.

Eligibility:

High school and undergraduate students from all countries are eligible to apply for the competition.

Participants will need access to a computer and internet connection. All workshops will be conducted virtually.
